



Eligibity Criteria for Certificate

1. Attendance Requirement

A student must attend at least 75% of the scheduled classes to be eligible for certification.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- Course Completion: Students must complete all assigned coursework, including lectures, workshops, and practical exercises.
- **Homework Submission:** All homework assignments must be submitted on time and meet the specified quality standards.
- **Final Assignment**: Students must complete their final assignment and receive a satisfactory evaluation from their mentor.

3. Final Assignment Evaluation

The Final Project will be evaluated by the student's mentor in two stages:

- Preliminary Assessment: The mentor will provide feedback and identify areas for improvement.
- **Final Assessment:** The mentor will determine the final evaluation of the project, taking into account the student's overall performance and the quality of the Final Project.

4. Certificate of Proficiency

- **Evaluation Criteria:** The Certificate of Proficiency will be awarded based on the combined evaluation of the student's homework and assignments.
- **Mentor and TCF Decision:** The decision to award the certificate will be made by the student's mentor in consultation with the TCF office.
- Certificate of proficiency will be awarded on scoring at least 75% marks in each of the evaluation components and completion of final assignment.
- 5. Late Submission Policy (Assignment): A fine of INR 500 will be imposed.
- **6. Ethical Standards:** Students are expected to adhere to ethical guidelines and maintain a professional demeanor throughout the program.
- **7. Academic Integrity:** Students must adhere to strict academic integrity standards throughout the program.
- **8. Professional Conduct:** Students are expected to maintain professional conduct and behaviour.
- **9. Participation:** Active participation in class discussions, workshops, and group projects is encouraged.
